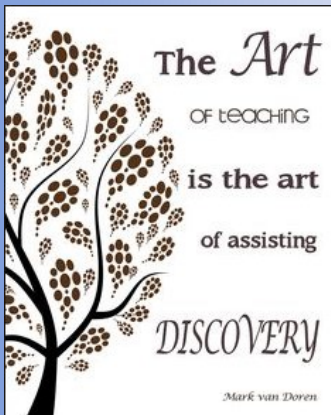

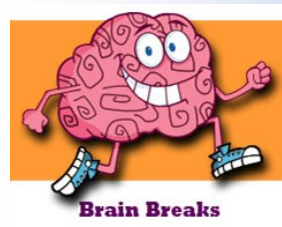
Brain Breaks Achieve Optimal Learning

Brain Breaks are brief activities (1-5 minutes each) designed to get students up and moving vigorously, thus increasing the flow of blood and oxygen to the brain. These activities recharge students putting them in a ready-state for learning and giving students an academic boost. Each Brain Break concludes with 30-45 seconds of cool-down breathing to settle children (and teachers!) to get them back in their seats and back on task. Teachers can use Brain Breaks at their discretion. They can be used when the class is lacking engagement, before a test, between segments of a lesson, or between every 20-30 minutes of continuous instruction.

Will County Partners for Healthy Families is working to increase the number of classrooms using Brain Breaks.

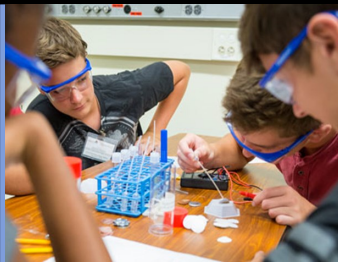
